



### **Getting to the EARLI Conference at the Mofet Institute from Ben Gurion Airport**

**By taxi:** Follow the signs to Taxis where you will find a line of people who are assigned a licensed taxi. The cost of a taxi during the day is 130 NIS and 150 NIS at night.

**By train:** There is a train that goes from the airport to Central Savidor Station in Tel Aviv. The cost of a one-way ticket is 14 NIS. From the Central Savidor Station, take the 29 bus which goes to the Mofet Institute.

The schedule of the buses: 6:30, 7:00, 7:40, 8:15, 13:05, 13:35, 14:10, 14:45, 15:35.

It is also possible to take any bus going north on the Namir Road

"Dan" buses: 26, 29, 90, 147, 149.

"Egged" buses: 501, 502, 852, 872, 910

"Kavim" 94, 95

Ask the bus driver to let you off at Kiryat Hinuch, at the pedestrian bridge. You need to cross the bridge (over the highway) and go to the Mofet Institute, which is located next to Levinsky College.

**By bus:** "Egged" bus #5 goes from the airport to "Airport City," where you take bus number 249 to Petach Tikva. From there, change to bus 641 to the Central Savidor Train Station in Tel Aviv. See the above explanation in "By train" for the continuation of the trip to the Mofet Institute.

### **Getting to the hotels in Tel Aviv from Ben Gurion Airport**

Hotel Sea Net, 6 Nes Ziona Str., Tel Aviv near the Opera Tower

Hotel Armon, 268 Hayarkon Str., Tel Aviv (at Yarkon/Yermiyahu and Yarkon/Nordau)

Hotel Port, 4 Yermiyahu Str., Tel Aviv (corner Hayarkon 288)

**By taxi:** Follow the signs to Taxis where you will find a line of people who are assigned a licensed taxi. The cost of a taxi during the day is 130 NIS and 150 NIS at night.

**By train:** There is a train that goes from the airport to Central Savidor Station in Tel Aviv. The train station is on Level S in the main building, near the Arrivals Hall. To buy a



ticket for the train ride, go to Level G where you will find automatic ticket machines. The trip to Central Savidor Station in Tel Aviv is 14 NIS.

From the Central Savidor Station in Tel Aviv, you can get to your hotel either by taxi or by bus.

A taxi will cost about 40 NIS.

Bus #55 goes straight to the hotels down Hayarkon Street to the Reading Power Station. The cost of a bus ticket is 5.80 NIS. The bus leaves every 15-30 minutes and runs from 05:15 to 23:30.

"Dan" bus #5 goes to Dizengoff 239 (corner Nordau) and from there it's a 300 meter walk to Hayarkon Street.

**During the Conference, there will be a bus which will take you from the hotel to the Mofet Institute.**

### **Getting from your hotel to the Mofet Institute**

By taxi: A taxi will cost about 50 NIS.

By bus: Take a #55 bus from Hayarkon Street or a #5 "Dan" bus from Dizengoff 239 (corner Nordau) to the Central Savidor Train Station. From there, take bus #29 or any bus going north on the Namir Road. Ask the bus driver to let you off at Kiryat Hinuch, at the pedestrian bridge. You need to cross the bridge (over the highway) and go to the Mofet Institute, which is located next to Levinsky College.
